E. CHINA C plays original rock/pop/transgenre music from its wanderings and wonderings through tonality, musical genres, and language. With not-infrequent digressions into silliness or irreverence.

Its music has something to interest, amuse, or confuse everyone — rock/pop, ballads, folk, bluegrass, and punk. With lyrics that ponder, parody, or perturb. . . and maybe, sometimes, embrace.

Band history

The **Coral Company & All-Naturals Band** began in Okinawa, in a studio overlooking the East China Sea. Since then, its members have lived mostly in southern and central parts of Arizona and have settled in the high-desert wildlands — east of Whetstone.

The band's initial activity lasted about five years. That was followed, many years later, by a second, several-year period that had to be suspended. Performing and composing resumed in 2014.

C released several cassette-tape and CD albums and "Myspace samplers," over the years, but its first commercial release — "Return to the C" — didn't come until 2018. Its second album — "DOH! *Re ♪ Me.*" — was released in 2023.

Band members performed at many open-mic nights in metropolitan Phoenix — beginning in 2005 — initially, in the band Almost NoRmL. **C** reformed, in 2008, and continued playing around the Valley through 2011.

A year or so after moving to the high desert, **C** resumed playing and composing. Shortly afterwards, the band returned to playing at open-mic nights — in Bisbee and Sierra Vista.

New album

The album "DOH! *Re ♪ Me.*" is the band's second release.

Nearly of the album's songs were composed during the band's second and most-recent periods of activity.

The playlist includes the usual rock/pop/mixed-genre songs, plus a Socratic dialogue on free will, a doo-wop love song, a psychological study, a point-of-view play, a waltz, and a song where the choruses come before the verses.

All recordings were engineered by the band — in its Tempe and subsequent Whetstone, Arizona, studios. All songs were composed by Lars Samson. Unnatural Noiz is the band's *virtual* recording label, but CD Baby is handling this album's distribution. CD Baby and ASCAP are responsible for legal/royalty arrangements.
